NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with section 114 of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 ("**FSMA**") that by an order dated 15 December 2020 (the "**Order**") the High Court of Justice in England and Wales has sanctioned a scheme (the "**Scheme**") for the transfer to Domestic & General Insurance Europe AG (the "**Transferee**"), whose registered address is Hagenauer Straße 44, 65203 Wiesbaden, Germany, of the whole of the European general insurance business, other than business where the state of risk is the United Kingdom, effected and/or carried out by Domestic & General Insurance Plc (the "**Transferor**") (the "**Transfer**") and under section 112 of FSMA has made various ancillary orders for implementing the Transfer.

The Transfer is intended to become effective at 22:58 (prevailing UK time) on 31 December 2020.

In accordance with the Order, the policyholders of policies which will transfer to the Transferee by virtue of the Scheme are hereby notified that they may exercise their rights (if any) under the law of the relevant EEA state in which the insured risk is situated to cancel their policy by notifying the Transferee in writing at the address stated above within a period of 21 days starting from the date of this publication or such other period (if any) as the law of the relevant EEA state provides.
